#### Facebook Analytics:

- Total Followers: 13,169

- Highlight: The engagement on Facebook is up 2500% and emonstrates a solid base of active supporters.

#### X (Formerly Twitter) Analytics:

- Highlight: 35% increase in overall impressions year-over-year. Stronger reach and engagement compared to the previous year. A clear trend of NJLP's growing influence impressions over these periods reflect the fluctuating engagement levels. Gained 336 new followers.

#### PR and Social Media Summary

This year marked a turning point in NJLP's media and social strategy. We transitioned to Buffer for scheduling and streamlining our social media content, enhancing consistency and outreach. Additionally, we actively published press releases over the wire to ensure our messaging reached a broader audience, while also securing three times more media mentions compared to the previous year. Our social media presence saw remarkable growth, with impressions on X increasing by 35% year-over-year, reaching 245,767 total impressions. Facebook engagement skyrocketed by 2,500%, demonstrating an expanding and engaged audience. The increasing number of reporters reaching out to us shows that NJLP's influence in the political landscape continues to rise.

Through these initiatives, we have strengthened NJLP's visibility and laid a strong foundation for future public relations efforts. The momentum built over the past two years ensures that the party will continue to expand its reach and impact.
