

Petition for the NJ General Election for Congressional District 3

Note that signers must be registered to vote in the 3rd district. Circulators of the petition should be registered voters in New Jersey – but not necessarily in district 3.

At any time once you have started gathering signatures take your petition booklet(s) to a Notary Public. At the Notary:

- Find the page titled “Affidavit of Person Who Circulates This Petition and Witness Signatures”.
- Print your name on the line as the Circulator/Witness
- While in front of the notary sign on the line “Signature of Circulator Witness.” Add your address below that. It should be the address where you are registered to vote.
- Notary should then fill out the information to the left of your signature.

Once you are done collecting signatures contact Jay at (848)525-0578 for collection. Petitions are due in Trenton on June 7th.

The Mercer County towns of **East Windsor, Hamilton, Hightstown, Lawrence, and Robbinsville**. The Monmouth County towns of **Allentown, Englishtown, Freehold, Freehold Township (part), Holmdel, Manalapan, Marlboro, Millstone, Roosevelt, and Upper Freehold**.
